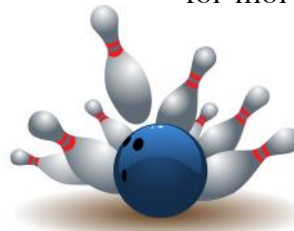
Youth group resumes September 7!
