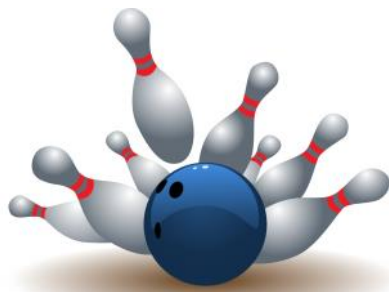
Youth group resumes this Sunday!
