Parish Picnic & Raffle!

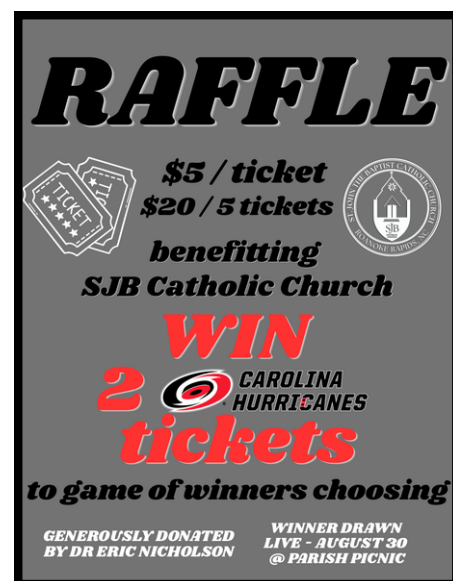
Our **parish picnic** will be a multi-cultural celebration starting right after the 11:30 Mass on **Sunday, August 30!**
